

Making Lanyards for Pilgrim Crosses

Supplies Needed:

Small French Knitter (four prongs)

Knitting needle or pointed stick to lift loops

Red Heart Brand **Mexicana** Yarn (Mexicana is the vivid rainbow colored yarn that is used for Emmaus Agape available at Walmart, Michaels, online and elsewhere
50 to 60 lanyards out of one skein

9mm split ring to attach cross Available through craft stores and Amazon (50 for 68 cents)
